 Workshop, ages 8-12
 Friday, July 13
 9:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m.*

Take a day to spend with a child, rediscovering the garden as a place of inquiry, a source of wonder, and a lot of fun! This one-day workshop includes cool science, inspiring art, and fun activities. Every adult/child pair receives a garden-magic book to embellish and use as a guide for the morning activities. Shuffle the Garden Guide cards and choose your activities randomly, or pick your favorites from the deck that includes Hula Hoop Botany, High-Flying Haikus, Insect Investigation and more. Pack a lunch to eat inside a Conservatory classroom, or on a blanket in the park. Spend the afternoon with artist Michelle Stitzlein and make your own flowers from recycled materials to add color and spirit to your garden at home.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Backyard Discovery, ages 4-5

Flying through the air, hopping in the grass, digging underground—insects are everywhere. Grab your bug jars and hand lenses and get to know your six-legged neighbors. Discover a rainbow of flowers and plant a butterfly garden to take home. Explore the wonders of nature in the Conservatory's outside gardens.

Little Travelers, ages 4-5

Celebrate culture in the Conservatory biomes with songs and stories from around the world. Journey from the mountains to the rainforest to the desert, and learn all about the plants and animals that live in each habitat. Sample exotic foods and make unique crafts to keep as mementos of your travels. Each day is a new adventure!

World Travelers, ages 6-8

The Conservatory biomes are the inspiration for cultural adventure in this workshop where you will experience customs, crafts and foods from around the world. Learn what it takes to trek to the top of Mt. Everest and how to stay dry in the rainforest. Eat a cactus, and learn how Native Americans use plants in the desert. It's a taste of world travel, right in our own backyard.

Nature Detectives, ages 6-8

Investigate the habitats in Franklin Park and use your detective skills to discover fun surprises at every turn. Search for clues to find out what animals live in the park and how they make their homes. Investigate soil, seeds, and sprouts to learn how plants grow. Make gadgets to help you explore the wonders of animals, plants, and the natural world.

Art Adventure, ages 8-12

Calling budding artists—come to the garden for inspiration! Let the wonders of the natural world and Chihuly's beautiful glass art stimulate your creativity. Try your hand at a variety of art mediums including glass and paint. Explore the beauty of nature and create some beauty of your own.

Survivor!, ages 9-12

Imagine you are lost in the jungle, stranded on an island, or crossing the desert on foot. The Conservatory becomes a playground for the imagination as you use plants, hand-made tools, and your know-how to survive. Learn to identify edible plants, make your own fishing pole, and use a compass. Keep track of it all in a handmade survival manual to guide you on your next adventure.
