


Community Garden Plot Rental Program

Community Gardens provide the opportunity to grow food and ornamental plants, the exchange of gardening tips and experiences between neighbors, and the enhancement of neighborhood beauty. As part of the Conservatory's *Growing to Green* program, a limited number of community garden plots will be available in the Franklin Park Community Garden. This garden will not only be a functional community garden but will serve as a model for other groups to use in developing their own site.

Plot Sizes and cost per season if available (most are the 8'X12' size)



Resources

- Tools, on loan, during regularly scheduled work sessions
- Water hookups and hoses on site
- Guidance from trained Conservatory staff throughout the growing season
- The opportunity to interact with other gardeners (aspiring and experienced)

Requirements

Garden plot holders are required to volunteer 10 hours per season in the common areas of the Community Garden or Conservatory. Plot holders can opt-out of this requirement for an additional \$20 fee.



Availability

Plots are assigned in the order in which requests are received and by availability at the Growing to Green office.

To place your name placed on the waiting list for a plot, email growingtogreen@fpconservatory.org - put "Plot Request" in the subject line and your contact info in the body of the email. The waiting list is typically very long and may take a season or two to get in, check your status in February by emailing the above address.
