The Conservatory's vision is a world that celebrates nature as essential to the human experience, and the pandemic has only heightened that purpose.

The Conservatory will monitor the situation as it changes. The policies below are in effect as of early September; however, please check our website for the most up to date health and safety policies.

🍂 **VISITING:** If you are experiencing symptoms, please visit at a later date.

🍂 **TICKETING:** Reserving tickets in advance ensures the easiest check-in experience and guarantees you are able to visit during your preferred date and time.

🍂 **FACE COVERINGS:** The City of Columbus mandates all guests must wear face coverings while indoors, regardless of vaccination status. Unvaccinated guests should wear face coverings during their entire visit.

CHIHULY COLLECTION

ON PERMANENT VIEW

The Chihuly Collection, the largest permanent collection in a botanical garden, remains on view daily. Eighteen installations of stunning glass art are placed throughout the interior Conservatory. *The final Chihuly Night of the year is October 9, 7–10pm.*
